The Pedders Suspension 5030 is a critical steering bearing that carries all the turning load of the front of the vehicle on all commodores from VR - VE. Most of us know that these bearings are prone to popping apart on disassembly of the strut but also wear from constant load and impact and can become notchy and effect steering precision, particularly in wet and dusty conditions where the drain holes get blocked resulting in water getting in to the bearings.

The Pedders Suspension 5030 bearings are a premium replacement part to solve these problems and complement the Pedders Suspension heavy duty rubber 5851 top mount.

Pedders 5851 which is a heavy duty top mount that withstands the loads applied in everyday driving. With the 5851 Pedders have redesigned the steel reinforcement plates to reduce the internal stress's applied to the mount. Along with redesigning the mouldings and using improved rubber the 5851 improves longevity. Compared to the OE equivalent the 5851 strut mount restricts flex and improves handling and shock absorption, providing the owner with precise turn in and improved drivability.







This worn top mount has come loose. This is a common fault once the unit has failed.



This is what a new top mount looks like once fitted. Pedders recommends the use and fitment of its 5030 and 5851 for the top mounts of Holden Commodore VR-VE models.
